### **Adjudicator: Silver Sands Guitar Trio (Perth / Kuala Lumpur)**

**Jonathan Paget** is a leading Australian exponent of the classical guitar. A Fulbright and Hackett scholar, Paget holds Masters and Doctoral degrees from the Eastman School of Music (USA). He is a senior lecturer at the Western Australian Academy of Performing Arts, Edith Cowan University (Perth) and Acting Associate Dean of Research. Paget has supervised postgraduate research on a variety of topics, and has published on Sculthorpe, Australian guitar music, and music analysis. As a guitarist, he has won first prize in multiple national and international competitions, has performed with leading musicians such as Slava Grigoryan, Karin Schaupp, and Pavarotti, and has appeared at significant festivals such as the Darwin International Guitar Festival, the Perth International Arts Festival, and the Port Fairy Spring Music Festival. He has released two solo CDs: *Kaleidoscope*, and *Midsummer's Night* (Move Records), which have been played extensively on radio.

**Craig Lake** currently balances a demanding teaching schedule as a staff member of the School of Instrumental Music (Department of Education and Training, Western Australia), and lectures in guitar at the Western Australian Academy of Performing Arts (Perth). He regularly performs in duo with guitarist Jonathan Paget, and is also an exponent of the theorbo, having performed with some of Australia's leading baroque musicians such as Sara MacLiver, Fiona Campbell, Stewart Smith and Paul Wright.

**Nathan Fischer** is a Senior Lecturer of Classical Guitar with the Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM) in Kuala Lumpur Malaysia. As a concert artist Nathan has appeared in the United States, Europe, Eastern Europe, Russia, the Middle East, Oceania, and Southeast Asia. His research focus has been on the performance and analysis of music for classical guitar with specialization in Malaysian, Egyptian, and Venezuelan music, and has been supported by prestigious grants from the Howard Hanson Institute, the Fromm Foundation, Fulbright, and AUC. His method for guitar and Malaysian graded repertoire are set to be published by UiTM Press. Through granting organizations, Nathan has worked with composers Kye Ryung Park, Aaron Travers, Ahmed Madkour, Karim Frège, Kirk-Even Billet, and Tazul Izan Tajuddin. In addition, he has premiered works by Michael Smetanin, Ross Carey, Katia Tiutiunnik, Ainolnaim Azizol, Raja Alif, Andrew Zohn, Valerie Ross, Az Samad, Sharmine Bakri, and Vincent Lindsey-Clark. Nathan holds Masters and Doctoral degrees from the Eastman School of Music. He is the president and founder of the International Guitar Institute (est. 2006), has held faculty positions at the American University in Cairo, State University of New York (Fredonia), and the University of Nevada (Las Vegas). In 2013, UiTM awarded him the Outstanding Service award for his success with motivating students.
